Duties & Responsibilities of Theatre Council Members

The mission of Theatre Workshop of Nantucket (TWN) is to entertain, enrich, educate, challenge and inspire performing artists and audiences of all ages. Working with members of the community and visiting artists, and collaborating with other cultural organizations, TWN produces a variety of theatrical works that reflect the highest artistic standards.

Theatre Council members advise TWN on advancing its mission and serve as advocates for the organization and its programs. They stay well informed and assist in promoting TWN by attending meetings of the Board. However, they are not “Directors” of the Corporation, so they have no fiduciary responsibility, nor do they have the right to vote, within the meaning of Chapter 180 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

Theatre Council members are expected to:

- Attend, in person or via teleconferencing, at least two Board meetings per year.
- Protect TWN’s confidential information, including without limitation, financial information; information relating to current and future business plans and operations; information regarding employees and individuals affiliated with or doing business with TWN; information regarding potential actions or recommendations under consideration by the Board or any committee; and any information that the Board or any committee declares or requests be kept confidential.
- Make TWN a top philanthropic priority, and make suggested **annual donation of at \$2,000**, due and payable by April 1st of each year.
- Attend at least two TWN productions per year and support other TWN events.

I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understand the Duties & Responsibilities of TWN Theatre Council members, and I will endeavor to carry them out to the best of my ability.
