ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

We, Everett U. Crosby, President, Barbara W. Nelson, Treasurer,

and Grace M. Klingelfuss

being a majority of the directors (or officers having the power of directors)

of The Theatre Workshop, Inc.

electd at its first meeting, in compliance with the requirements of General Laws, Chapter 180,
Section 8, hereby certify that the following is a true copy of the agreement of association to form
said corporation, with the names of the subscribers thereto:

We, whose names are hereto subscribed, do, by this agreement, associate ourselves with the
intention of forming a corporation under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 180.

The name by which the corporation shall be known is The Theatre Workshop, Inc.

The location of the principal office of the corporation in Massachusetts is to be the Town of
Nantucket, Main Street

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

to promote the welfare, culture, education and entertainment of
the Town of Nantucket by presenting, producing, managing, con-
ducting at any theatre, hall or place, plays, dramas, comedies,
operas, pantomines, concerts, musical and other pieces, ballets,
shows, exhibitions, moving pictures, variety and other entertain-
ments; to do everything necessary, suitable, proper, desirable or
incidental thereto; to do all things conducive to or expedient for
the protection or benefit thereof, including buying, selling, holding,
leasing, mortgaging, and disposing of real and personal property of
every nature; to do any thing not contrary to law, to the laws of the
Commonwealth of Massachusetts or the United States of America.

We hereby waive all requirements of the General Laws of Massachusetts for notice of the
first meeting for organization, and appoint the 19th day of April, 1957,
at 4 o'clock P.M., at 28 Orange Street, Nantucket
